



INTERNSHIP opportunities with KPMG in Moldova

When do internships take place?

The internship program is expected to take place in the period **January - May 2010**. Internships are available in the Audit department.

Internships during this period provide students with an excellent opportunity to get acquainted with the business of leading Moldovan and international companies, work on real projects together with KPMG professionals as well as making practical use of their academic knowledge.
